What?

U360 is an experiential education internship program with the nonprofit Manomet. You'll have the opportunity to engage with small businesses nationwide around sustainability, and apply what you're learning in the classroom to real-world scenarios. Manomet provides trainings to develop your professional skills and strengthen your understanding of sustainability concepts. You'll learn how to research and contact small businesses, and interview them about their current business practices. At the end of the semester, you'll create a Case Study and Sustainability Action Plan for one business and present it to a panel of small business leaders.

Who?

U360 is designed for students enrolled in business, economics, and/or environmental programs.

Why?

Through participation in the U360 program, you will:

- » Develop professional skills, such as communication, networking, time management, interviewing, public presentations, etc.
- » Gain experience working with a nonprofit organization
- » Learn how to apply general sustainability principles to specific scenarios
- » Create relationships with business owners prior to entering the workforce
- » Deepen your understanding of sustainability and small business management through real-world engagement

When?

U360 will be offered in the Spring and Fall 2017 semesters for sophomores and higher.
